

Over the years the Wurzels have appeared in nearly every town in Great Britain and have appeared on numerous television and radio shows as well as releasing a steady stream of L.P's and single records.

On 23rd April 1976 "Combine Harvester" was released and after numerous plays on the B.B.C. and commercial radio stations the record entered the charts. Eventually making the number one spot for two weeks and staying in the top fifty for 13 weeks with total sales of over 350,000.

Next an L.P. 'titled ''Combine Harvester'' was released and stayed in the top fifty L.P. chart for 18 weeks.

The follow up single called "I am a cider drinker" reached number 3 and sold over 250,000. Silver discs were received for each of the singles and also the L.P.

The new single is "Morning Glory".

After 10 years The Wurzels are here to stay with tours of Canada, Australia and New Zealand set for 1977.
